We have a number of children that are awaiting results after taking a PCR. If any class reaches 10% of positive cases this, then we would just let that class know as this is when it is advised that all the class get a PCR booked.

As a school we are trying not to let this affect school life too much within our guidelines. Today it was lovely to see our children supporting Children in Need. Each event will be looked at individually so some events will still take place while others may need to be cancelled/postponed.
