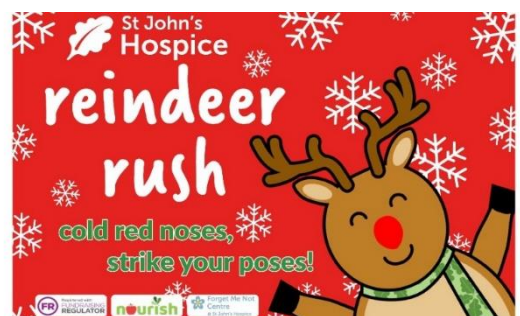
We wish all our children and their families a wonderful and fun-packed Christmas Holiday. It has been a memorable term!!!
