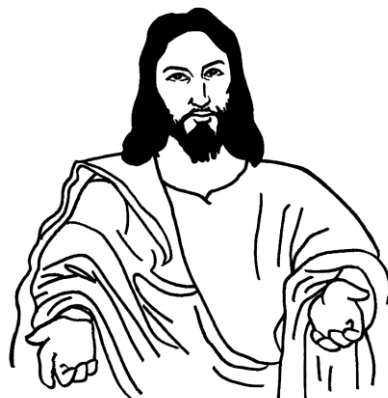

- O2 Virgin Mobile
- Sky Mobile Three
- SMARTY Tesco Mobile
