Friday message

From today guidance for COVID has changed. It is now treated as a sickness like having flu with the following guidelines:

- adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days

We will no longer be writing risk assessments or be supplying work for children off school. The school will also be disbanding the positive case email. As with any illness please leave a message on option 2 of the telephone system to report your child's absence.
