Her card has gone to the Queen, Prince Charles and Prince William! (Her design is the Santa). Brilliant achievement Grace.

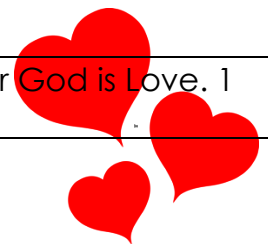


Turnstones Class Worship

Current cases in school are now quite steady with only a small number of children self-isolating.

We are sending out today a separate letter about how guidelines have changed from the Government about PCR tests etc from January 11th 2022.
