Sports Day

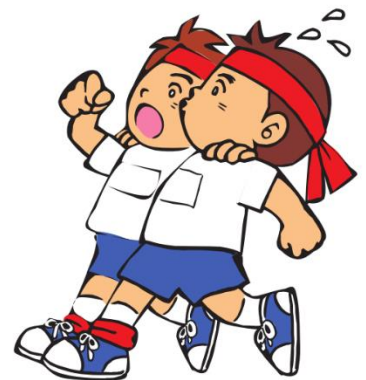
