Dear Parents/carers,

I have been informed today that two children in Year 6 have started with symptoms today and currently having a test. Until we are notified of the test result, I have decided to close the Year 6 Bubble as of tomorrow Monday 11th January and will be asking the children to self-isolate. This has been agreed with Mr. Dodgson, Chair of Governors. As soon as I have any further news on the test result, I shall let you all know. Children will be expected to all access our remote learning on Showbie.

I appreciate this may cause some concern. However, in line with the advice given, school will be open to all other year groups as normal tomorrow including siblings of those in Year 6.

If the test is negative, then the children will be able to return to school on the following day. If the test is positive, then Year 6 will be closed for a period of time.
