Please could we request that no nuts are brought into school or any items containing nut products. We have children who are allergic. Thank you

Earrings

A polite reminder to all families that earrings are NOT PERMITTED in school time. If children should forget to take them out and arrive at school wearing them, staff will:-

- Ask them to take them out (put safe to take home)
- If children cannot manage to take them out, parents will receive a text reminder to ensure earrings are removed for the next day.
- Provision for keeping the child safe will be made by covering up the earrings with hypo allergic tape (no child will be excluded from PE or playtime for wearing earrings that day)
- If the child's ears struggle to heal, spacers may be worn temporarily while the ears heal fully. This is not a replacement for earrings as a long term solution.
